Minutes of the work and meetings of the Committee

29 May 2018

The Committee for the Giovanni Anania Fellowship 2018, composed by Professors Anna Carbone, Rosanna Nisticò and Donato Romano, in cooperation with colleagues at DARE-Davis, examined all the applications submitted by the deadline and, after thorough consideration, reached its final decision about the proposals.

The committee had agreed to adopt the same decision criteria of 2016 and 2017 editions:

- a) CV (10%): education, skills;
- b) Reference letter (10%): referee's reputation;
- c) Proposal quality (50%): justification, relevance, topics;
- d) Agreement of the UC Davis (30%): consistency with the research topics currently developed at UC Davis, availability of an interested supervisor.

The PhD candidates who applied are overall 23 of which 16 have been excluded due to failures in meeting basics requirements. The remaining 7 where all eligible and have been evaluated positively. According to the evaluation criteria the selected one is the proposal by:

The Committee unanimously agreed to assign the 2018 scholarship to the project titled:

The size-productivity relationship in the European agriculture. Leveraging farm-level data to account for farms technological heterogeneity.
