Who we are

The Manlio Rossi-Doria Centre was established at Roma Tre University in 2013, as a centre of excellence in economic and social research.

Through its interdisciplinary approach, the Centre actively conducts research and promotes knowledge advancement in economic and human development. Current research areas include, but are not limited to: agriculture, food security, environmental sustainability and energy issues; international relations and trade, foreign investment, global value chains; the Italian economy, with a focus on Southern Italy, cohesion and development policies; European integration; analysis and evaluation of policies; human development.

Manlio Rossi-Doria

Manlio Rossi-Doria (1905-1988) was an Italian intellectual and politician. Following the footsteps of distinguished predecessors Giustino Fortunato and Francesco Saverio Nitti, Rossi-Doria devoted both his analysis and political engagement to the issues of the socio-economic development of Southern Italy.

An outspoken anti-fascist, during the fascist *ventennio* he was trialled for subversive political activities and sentenced to confinement in Basilicata; from there, he participated in the foundation of the anti-fascist *Partito d'Azione*. Subsequently, he established himself as a prominent voice in the political life of the new-born Italian Republic. His scientific commitment as an agricultural economist was characterised by a profound and continuous intertwining with institutional appointments and experiences.

His rigour in the scientific approach, his nuanced knowledge of the primary sector and of rural society, and his neat and engaging writing style made him a mentor and a point of reference for many generations of social and economic scientists.
