Saul Estrin is an emeritus **Professor of Managerial Economics and Strategy** and was the founding **Head of the Department of Management at LSE**. He was formerly a Professor of Economics, and Associate Dean (Faculty and Research), at London Business School. He also held the Adecco Professorship of Business and Society at London Business School and was the Research Director of its Centre for New and Emerging Markets. At LSE he is an Associate Fellow of the <u>Centre for Economic Performance</u> and a Visiting Professor at the Marshall Institute.
